August 1, 1918 - August 22, 2019

Wilma (Sledge) Jenkins, 101, of Centralia, passed away Thursday, August 22, 2019 at 2:03 PM at her home surrounded by her family.

She was born August 1, 1918 in Jefferson County, daughter of Raymond Sledge and Ruby (Humphrey) Sledge. She married Kenneth "Kenny" Jenkins on March 14, 1942 in St. Charles, Missouri and he preceded her in death on May 1, 1969.
