



Alexander Korzenewski

April 15, 1928 - June 16, 2023

Alexander "Tyrod" Korzenewski, a resident of Abilene since 1953, died Friday, June 16, 2023 at his home. Born April 15, 1928 in Glenridge (Junction City) Illinois, he was the son of the late Joseph Korzenewski and Anna Puleikus Korzenewski. He graduated from Sandoval High School, Sandoval, Illinois where he excelled in basketball. He graduated in 1946 and joined the U S Navy and was stationed at Whiting Field Naval Air Station, Florida where he was a telephone operator and played basketball for the Whiting Bombers. He later attended The University of Southern Illinois. He went to work with Hack Drilling Company in Illinois. The company later moved to West Texas during the oil boom of the '50's. He met and married Pat Lane of Cross Plains, Texas May 17, 1953. They moved to Abilene later that year. He continued in oil field work until his retirement in 1988.
