Alvin J. Holthaus, 82, of Centralia, passed away Thursday, April 27, 2023 at Barnes Jewish Hospital in St. Louis, Missouri.

He was born March 12, 1941 in Breese, the son of Joseph Holthaus and Janina (Tyl) Holthaus. He married Mary Salatino on December 27, 1971 and she survives.

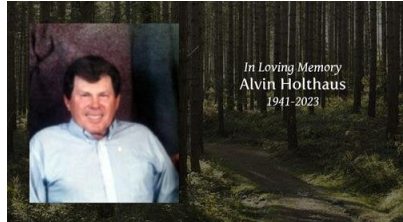
