Ann Elizabeth Spiller, 99, of Louisville, KY and formerly of Centralia, died peacefully Thursday, December 13, 2012 after a short illness. The daughter of Irene and Frederick Scharp, Ann was born June 14, 1913 in Toledo, OH. After graduating from nursing school in Toledo in 1935 she married Adelbert L. Spiller M.D. of Carbondale, IL on May 13, 1937. They moved to Centralia in 1941, where Ann lived and kept her own home on Lilac Lane until moving to Louisville at age 98 to be near her daughter Susan. She was a long time attendee of the First United Presbyterian Church in Centralia. Ann was preceded in death by Dr. Spiller in 1992, and by her brother and four sisters. She is survived by her daughter Susan Mayes (Rick) of Louisville, grandson Bob Mayes (Paula) of San Francisco, CA and granddaughter Beth Mayes (Christopher Schwan) of Seattle, WA. A memorial service will be held Thursday, January 10, 2013 at 11:00 A.M. at the First United Presbyterian Church in Centralia with Dr. Ed Evans officiating.
