Arthur F. Little, 80 of Boulder, born November 28, 1933 in rural Warren County, Indiana died June 1, 2014 at 11:50 A.M. Arthur "Frank" retired as Chief Master Sergeant (Air Reserve Technician) at Scott Air Force Base, Illinois in November of 1993 with over 41 years service in the Air Force Reserve and Army National Guard.
