Barbara Faye Beaumont, a beloved member of the Centralia community, passed away peacefully on Saturday, May 31st, 2025, at the age of 82 at her Great niece: Char-Lee Godfrey's house, where she was taken care of with the help of great great nephew and niece: Zechariah and Zoe for the last month of her life. Born on Wednesday, May 26th, 1943 in Centralia, Illinois, the daughter of Jacob Fayette Reichenbach and Beatrice O. (Toedte) Reichenbach. She married D.C. Beaumont on June 3, 1972 in Centralia, and he preceded her in death.
