Blaine Jordan Pinkston, 91, of Patoka, IL passed away June 27, 2020 at Salem Township Hospital Emergency Room, with family by his side.

Born July 21, 1928 in Moweaqua, Illinois, he was the son of Lawrence and Aileen (Jordan) Pinkston.

For many years, Blaine was a resident of Shelby and Christian Counties, most of his life as a resident of Assumption, Pana, Ramsey, Tower Hill and Oconee. He moved to Patoka following his marriage. He was a farmer, auctioneer, live stock trader and owner of the Pinkston Sale Pavilion. He also served his country faithfully in the United States Marines.
