Charles Dwight Pugh, 93, of Centralia, passed away Sunday, May 19, 2019 at SSM Health Good Samaritan Hospital in Mt. Vernon.

Charles was born August 14, 1925 in Jefferson County, son of Etta (Cooper) Pugh and Everett Hawkins. He married Edna Mae George on July 22, 1946 and she preceded him in death. Charles served in the U.S. Army during WWII.
