Dan Galbreath, 93, of Centralia, passed away Saturday, December 28, 2019 at his home.

He was born on September 27, 1926 in Kansas, Illinois the son of Reynold Galbreath and Dortha (Miller) Galbreath Scott. He married the love of his life, Peggy Swain, on December 9, 1961 and she survives in Centralia.

In addition to his wife of 58 years, Peggy Galbreath of Centralia, he is also survived by his two children: Bruce Galbreath of Colorado Springs, CO and Stephanie Heinrich and husband Mike of Centralia; a grandson: Josh Warden and wife Megan of Centralia; two great grandchildren: Addison and Havlynn; several nieces and nephews.

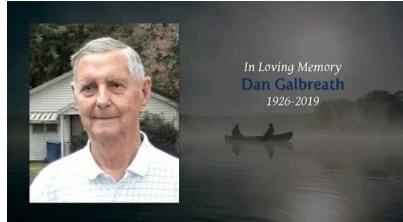
