Darrell Lee Shook, a lifelong resident of Centralia, Illinois, passed away peacefully on Thursday, February 5, 2026, at the age of 81. Born and raised in Centralia, Darrell is the son of Chris Shook and Marie (Shaw) Shook. He married Patricia Robbins on April 2, 1965 and they later divorced. He later married Carol Hart on February 28, 1991 in Boyd, Il and they later divorced.
