



## Dennis Eggle

Dennis "Denny" Eggle, 65, of Central City, passed away, Thursday, September 22, 2022 at his home.

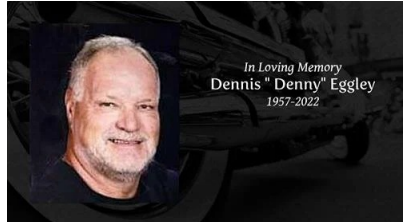
