Emil Thomas Hill, age 95, of Centralia, IL, passed away on Saturday, September 19, 2015 at Fireside Nursing Home in Centralia. Emil was born on December 6, 1919 in Lebanon, MO, a son to John Thomas and Esther Caroline (Hughes) Hill. He married Virginia Hill on August 12, 1941 and she preceded him in death on October 23, 2008.
