Maxine (Ludington) Kinder Quick, 93, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri formerly of Centralia, passed away Wednesday, July 24, 2019 at Ratliff Care Center in Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

She was born June 24, 1926 in Kirkwood, Illinois, daughter of John Ludington and Ellen Mae (Robins) Ludington. Maxine married Marion Kinder in August of 1946 and he preceded her in death on April 3, 1951. She married Claud Quick on July 4, 1954 and he preceded her in death in October of 1986.

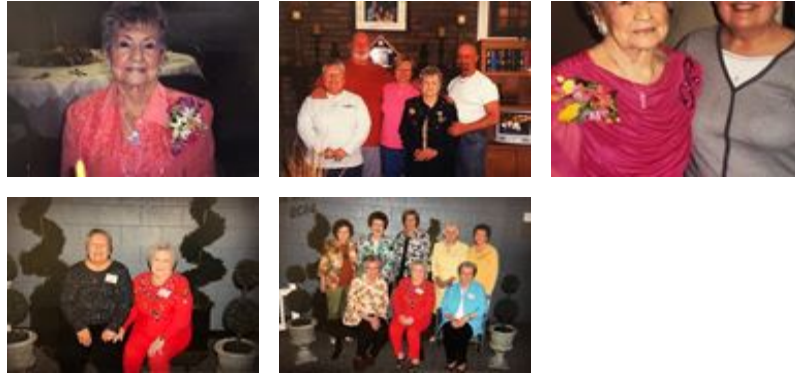
