Gilbert F. Logan, 96, of Centralia, passed away Saturday, April 20, 2019 at SSM Health St. Mary's Hospital in Centralia, Illinois.

Gilbert was born June 4, 1922 in Irvington, Illinois. He was the son of Roy Logan and Eva (Raines) Logan. Gilbert was raised in Irvington and entered the United States Navy and he also served in the United States Marines with the Sixth Marine Corps in the South Pacific. The Marines were ready to enter Japan when President Truman ordered the atomic bomb dropped on Japan, August 6, 1945. Gilbert then returned home to Irvington after serving four years with the Marine Corps. He was employed with Sears Roebuck for 35 years and married Phyllis Maddox on June 2, 1950 at First Baptist Church in Centralia.
