Helmuth Henry Harms, age 83, of Centralia, passed away on Saturday, July 18, 2015, encircled by his loving family. Helmuth was born on March 23, 1932, in Good Thunder, Minnesota, the son of Ferdinand "Ferd" and Alma (Adermann) Harms. On August 16, 1958, he married Ruby Renken in Edwardsville, Illinois, and she survives him in Centralia. He served as Scholar Bowl coach--even into his retirement years. He was a camp counselor at Piasa, was an ambassador at Kaskaskia

College after retirement, served as an election judge, was on the board for the Centralia Cultural Society, a member of Rotary and served as Rotary President for one year, he held office in the Southern Illinois District of the Lutheran Church, and he was a past president of the Spirited Seniors group at Trinity. He enjoyed playing card games with his friends and golfing--but most of all, he enjoyed his time with his family and friends. Funeral services will be held on Thursday, July 23rd, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Centralia at 10:00 am with Pastor Mark Girardin and Pastor Perry Schefelker officiating. Visitation will be held from 5:00 pm until 8:00 pm on Wednesday, July 22nd, at the church, and from 9:00 am until 10:00 am at the church on Thursday morning. Interment will follow at Valley View Cemetery in Edwardsville, Illinois, at 2:00 pm.
