Henry Michael "Mike" Wolenhaupt, 75, of Centralia, passed away Monday, July 21, 2025 at Odin Healthcare Center.

He was born on August 10, 1949 to Henry and Bernice Wolenhaupt. He was the oldest of three brothers Marc and Brad.

His calling as a highly talented craftsman began at a very early age.

Throughout his career he wore many different hats most notably as a carpenter builder and auto body expert.
