Howard Charles "Chuck" Baldrige, 67, of Mt. Vernon, passed away Wednesday, June 22, 2022 at the Centralia Fireside Nursing Home. He was born April 9, 1955 in Peoria, the son of Howard A. Baldrige and Margaret (McAfee) Baldrige. He married Tomi Quick on July 17, 1976 and she preceded him in death on April 22, 2016.

Chuck is survived by his companion: Judy Luer of Mt. Vernon, his brother: Dale Dawson and wife Jani, special niece: Katrice Keenan and family; and several nieces and nephews.
