Imogene M. Silger, age 95 of rural Centralia, passed away Tuesday, January 24, 2023 at Carlyle Health Care Center.

Imogene was born April 11, 1927 in Richview, the daughter of Frank E. Huck and Anna (Krietemeyer) Huck. She married Paul J. Silger on April 24, 1948 in Norris City, IL and he preceded her in death on December 29, 2018 after 70 years of marriage. 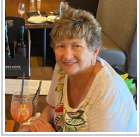
