



## Inez Stover

May 5, 1924 - May 4, 2022

Inez Stover, 97, of Centralia, passed away Wednesday, May 4, 2022 at her home, surrounded by her family.

She was born May 5, 1924 in Centralia, the daughter of Ernest Snider and Minnie (Davis) Snider. She married Frank Stover on June 8, 1947 and he preceded her in death on October 18, 1996.

Inez was born and raised in Centralia. She was the last surviving Snider sister of eight girls. She attended the Zion Hill School, which was a one room grade school, and she was a graduate of the Centralia Township High School Class of 1943. Inez retired from Illinois Bell after 30 years of service. She then worked with her husband, Frank, at the Stover's Jewelry Store and Cupboard Natural Food Shop in Centralia.

Inez was a member of the Zion Hill Missionary Baptist Church in rural Centralia for many years and later moved her membership to the First Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Centralia.

Inez had a passion for growing and taking care of flowers and doing yard work. She also, enjoyed cooking. Inez's pride and joy was her family. She cherished the time she spent with her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren.
