Jack D. Hamburg, Sr., 88, of Centralia, passed away at 4:08 AM on Wednesday, April 26, 2017 at Odin Healthcare Center.

He was born January 17, 1929 in Centralia, son of Volney Swaim and Ethel (Davis) Swaim. As an infant, he was adopted by his aunt and uncle Goldie (Davis) Hamburg and Arthur Wesley Hamburg.
