She attended St. Mary Catholic Grade School and Centralia Township High School graduating in 1949. She married William "Bill" W. Nall, Jr., on June 3, 1950. Together they had three sons, Stephen "Steve" (Vickie) Nall, Arthur "Art" (Melissa) Nall, and V. Rev. James Nall, JCL. She was preceded in death by her parents and husband.
