Michael L. Ellis, a beloved husband, father, papa, brother, and friend, passed away peacefully on Friday, July 25, 2025, at the age of 73. Born on November 19, 1951, son of Jack Ellis and Catherine "Katie" (Uhls) Ellis. Michael, affectionately known as "Hawk," was a lifelong resident of Centralia, Illinois, where he dedicated his life to his family, community, and passions.
