



## Orlando S. Cortelloni

Orlando Cortelloni, 85 of Centralia, passed away Friday, May 9, 2014 in Paducah, Kentucky. Orlando was born July 28, 1928, son of Oresto Cortelloni and Mary (Hoeinghaus) Cortelloni.
