



## Philip Quandt

September 26, 1951 - March 9, 2026

Philip Quandt, 74, of Centralia, passed away peacefully on Monday, March 9, 2026 at SSM Health St. Mary Hospital in Richmond Heights, Missouri, surrounded by his family. Phil was born September 26, 1951 in Salem, son of Clarence Quandt and Helen (Kleiss) Quandt. On March 6, 1974 in Salem, Phil married the love of his life, Glenda "Gay" Geiler and she preceded him in death on November 23, 2018.

Phil graduated from Kinmundy-Alma High School in 1969 and remained close with many of his classmates throughout his life. He especially enjoyed attending the monthly luncheons with the Kinmundy Class of 1969, where friendships continued to grow through the years. Phil worked for many years at the Centralia Correctional Center and was also the owner and operator of Phil's Lawn Mower, serving many customers in the community. He was a member of St. Mary Catholic Church in Centralia and was a proud 4th Degree member of the Knights of Columbus. He faithfully served alongside his brother Knights and was especially known for helping cook at the Knights of Columbus breakfasts. It was there that some of the guys affectionately began calling him "Bacon." Phil enjoyed spending time at the KC Hall with his fellow Knights, particularly on Friday nights and Sunday afternoons. He was always willing to volunteer whenever the Knights were asked to assist with church activities, including Autumn Fest and other parish events. Phil will be remembered for his generous spirit, dedication to his church and community,

and the friendships he cherished throughout his life.

He is survived by his four sons: Mike Casseday and wife Tammy of Centralia, Bart Casseday and special friend Jenita Colclasure of Farina, Shane Quandt and wife Helen of Steelville, and Eric Quandt and wife Melissa of Walnut Hill; seven grandchildren: Adam Casseday, Amber Casseday, Zachary Cassedy, Leah Diss, Luke Smith, Keegan Quandt, and Aria Quandt; four great-granddaughters: Hadlea Casseday, Emma Casseday, Freya Casseday, and Maisyn Diss; his sisters: Theresa (Craig) Stiven of St. Charles, Illinois, Benita (Dean) Langenfeld of Centralia, Regina (Jim) VanGeem of Carol Stream and Angela (Randy) Schnake of Irvington. 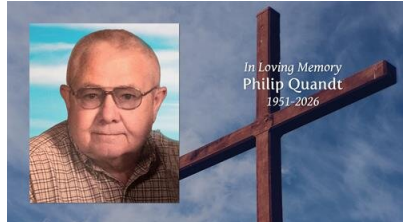
