Wahneta Delores Shaw, 89 of Centralia passed away Sunday, July 14, 2013 at Centralia Manor in Centralia. Wahneta was born September 19, 1923 in Centralia, daughter of Floid Heyduck and Hazel (Mathis) Heyduck. She married Robert Ramey on August 8, 1945 and he preceded her in death in 1958. She also married Wilson Hopkins, Jr. on October 8, 1960 and they later divorced and he preceded her in death in May 2013. She then married Paul Wendal Shaw on July 10, 1971 at the First Christian Church Disciples of Christ in Centralia and he survives in Centralia.
