Wanda Bass, 95, of Iuka, Illinois passed away at 10:30 p.m., on June 15, 2020 at Doctor's Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Salem,

She was born on August 29, 1924 in Alma, IL; she was the daughter of W. E. "Tom" Gregory and Lula (Grotts) Gregory who preceded her in death. She married Floyd C. Bass on March 21, 1942 in St. Charles, MO. He preceded her in death on June 27, 1999.

She was a very dedicated life long member of the Iuka United Methodist Church. She taught children's Sunday School and Bible School classes and served as pianist and organist for over 50 years.

She was employed as a retail clerk at Tresslar's 5 & 10 Store, known as one of the "Tresslar girls", until it closed its door, and later worked at the Salem Wal-Mart Store until she retired.
