William Edward Erbes, 85 of Centralia, passed away Tuesday, April 21, 2015 at his home surrounded by his family. Mr. Erbes was born December 13, 1929 in Centralia, son of William Edward Erbes, Sr. and Mildred (Buehne) Erbes. He married Marilyn May on January 28, 1951 at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Centralia and she survives in Centralia.
